Check Mate® Check Filler

- Bonds tightly to wood.
- Prevents water from getting into logs causing rot.
- Stretches as checks open and close.
- Prevents air infiltration into home.
- Can be used in gaps up to 1 inch wide.
- Easy to use.
- Soap and water clean up.
- Available in a variety of colors.

Check Mate forms a tough, smooth elastic seal that prevents water from getting into the wood and cold air into the home through cracks or checks in logs, timbers and siding. Although caulks may seem an obvious choice for this application, they are limited in their ability to withstand the rigorous conditions posed by the repeated opening and closing of a check from season to season.

General Application Instructions

Begin by cleaning the check or crack of any dust, dirt oil, solvent or previous sealer. If the check is upward-facing or has allowed previous water penetration, pour some mixed Shell-Guard® into it and allow to dry before proceeding. This will kill any decay fungi present and prevent further deterioration of the log due to rot. Using masking tape, mask off the wood on either side of the check. For checks 1/4" wide or larger, insert appropriately sized backer rod. Cut the tip of the tube to the approximate size of the check. Check Mate may then be applied into the check using standard caulk gun. Check Mate must have

good contact with wood on either side of the check and be sure the crack or check is completely sealed from end to end. Tool surface smooth with a wet finger and remove overflow immediately with a damp cloth. Masking tape should be removed while the Check Mate is still wet.

Frequency:

As needed.

Packaging:

11 oz. tubes, Check Kit.

Shelf Life/Application Temperature:

Check Mate has a shelf life of 1 year. Application temperature is between 40° to 90° F. Do not freeze!

Drying Time:

Dry to the touch in 1 hour, cures in 3 days.

Color:

Available in several Lifeline™ colors.

Coverage:

One ounce of Check Mate will fill 1 to 1.5 linear feet of a gap 1/2" wide.

Clean Up:

Wash hands and tools with soap and warm water.
